“Open Long after the Siren has Sounded”

Footy Park, (AAMI Stadium) will slowly be demolished over the coming months to make way for the brand-new WEST development. We here at Checkside Tavern will be staying put and developed over the long term into a brand-new facility on this site. While the development takes hold and the demolition rolls out, there may be some interruption to our business. We may change operation hours at short notice and have a constant change of our menu. It will be exciting times, so make sure you pop in on a regular basis to check it out.

The Tavern was first opened in November 1994 as the Football Park Auditorium. Over the years it traded as Crows Social Club and Crows Tavern before becoming “Checkside Tavern” in 2008.

The name “Checkside” is unique to South Australia as a sporting term. The phrase was listed on the Bank SA National Trust Heritage Icons List. It dates back to the halcyon days of the SANFL in the 1960’s, Jack Oatey and the Sturt Football Club. Even AFL commentators today have been heard to say “your in SA now, its not a banana, it’s a Checkside”.

The Checkside Tavern is fully owned and operated by the SANFL. The SANFL have over 140 year history of football in South Australia. In 2017, there were 612 teams, 12,130 participants playing more than 4,500 games across SANFL Juniors and SANFL Mini’s Competitions. The current plan is for the Checkside Tavern to stay operating on this site long after SANFL and AFL has left the hallowed grounds of West Lakes.

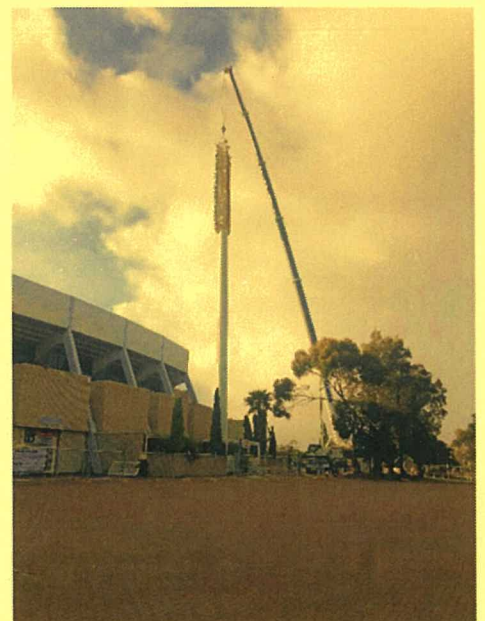
